# Onizuka Redevelopment Update

Acting as the local redevelopment authority for Onizuka Air Force Base, our City Council has narrowed their list of candidate development actions. Off the list are plans for a park, for a museum, for traditional tract housing, and for new city offices. Still on the list are plans for a corporate headquarters, for a hotel and conference center, for a car dealership, and for low-cost homes and apartments, which will be offered to the homeless.
